Our Model of Care

Many children globally live without access to care. Small cavities grow into serious decay and infection, affecting a child's ability to sleep, eat or pay attention in school.

Global Dental Relief volunteers work to restore children to dental health and bright smiles.

Children attend clinic class by class, and receive all necessary dental care, oral health instruction and a new toothbrush. Children return to clinic every two years.

2023 by the Numbers

Dental Clinics

- 28 volunteer dental clinics in seven countries globally: Mexico, Guatemala, Cambodia, Nepal, India, Kenya, and USA
- Volunteers served 22,382 amazing children (up 30% from the previous year) with \$5.4 million in donated care
- Care included 10,111 teeth restored, 5,067 cleanings, 4,195 extractions and 15,013 fluoride treatments

Oral Health Program

- 18,993 children reached through classroom visits, teaching oral health and giving each child a new toothbrush and fluoride treatment
- Oral health program operates in Nepal, Guatemala, and newest location of Cambodia

School Lunch Program

 239,000 nutritionally boosted lunches served to school children in Nepal


